

Outbound North 115**29 July 1942**

Fast convoy, 30 turns, beginning 0800, Day 1.

Escort Forces (Canadian Escort Group C-3, Cdr. Wallace, RCN, commanding): Saguenay, Skeena, Agassiz, Sackville, Louisville, Wetaskiwin,.

Reinforcements: Hamilton, Galt and Witch (RN).

There are no stragglers from the convoy at the start.

Fuel shortages may cause the original convoy escorts to break off for their base. Any turn that an escort is not in the AZ or CZ, roll D20. On a roll of 1, it is removed from play. Roll for each escort not in the AZ or CZ.

U-boat Forces: 13 U-boats, attack value 12, return value 2. One contact boat in the inner zone. Remainder off the playing area.
