## Slow Convoy 107

30 October 1942

Slow convoy. 38 turns, starting on 0400 Day 1

Escort Forces: (Canadian Escort Group C-4, Lt. Cdr. Desmond Piers, RCN, commanding) Restigouche, Algoma, Arvida, Celandine (RN). Additional escorting forces: Walker (RN), Columbia.

Reinforcements: Moosejaw, Vanessa (RN), Schenk (USN), Leary (USN), Ingham (USN), LR A, B, C, D and E.

All aircraft remain in play for the turn of their arrival only. Aircraft damaged or shot down do not appear again as reinforcements.

The convoy has no stragglers at the start of the scenario. It is accompanied by rescue ship Stockport, equipped with HF/DF.

U-boats: 16 U-boats, attack 11, return 3, flak 2. One contact boat is in the inner zone. The remainder are off the playing area but are eligible to enter on the first turn.

Outcome: In the time covered by this scenario, the U-boats sank 14 merchantmen. In the same period, the escorts killed two U-boats and damaged one. The kills were (in this period) a rare success for the escorting aircraft. While the escorts were helped by the fact that the battle began shortly after the convoy left Canada, with local escort forces still in attendance, they were hampered by their lack of effective radar. In a freak result, a third U-boat was apparently sunk when an ammunition ship in the convoy was hit and exploded.
